## Battery Installation

**Note:** This should be done in the morning on a sunny day. This will allow the solar light to receive a full 8 hours of sunlight so that the rechargeable battery can reach it's maximum charge.

Remove the 4 screws from the battery cover

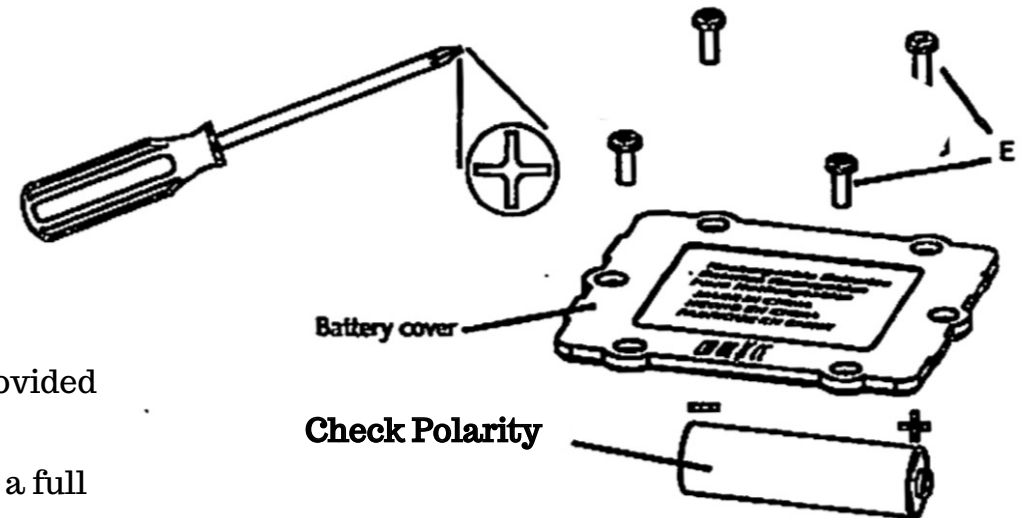
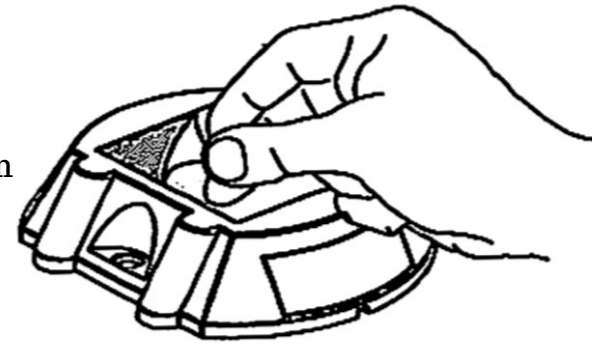
Replace the battery with 1 new AA size 1.2v rechargeable battery of the same or greater mAh rating.

Clean the battery contacts and those on the device prior to battery installation.

Be sure to insert the battery in the proper direction.

Reinstall the battery cover and tighten all the screws.

Remove the protective film from the Photocell before use

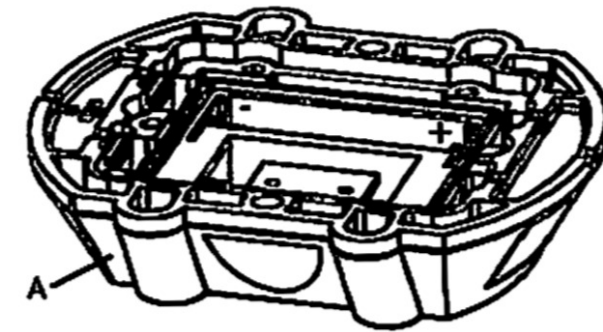


## Fixture Installation

**Note:** Depending on the surface material, other fasteners than the ones provided may be required.

Choose a location with as much direct sunlight as possible to receive a full charge daily.

After Choosing the location where you want to install the marker light. Using the wood screws provided, affix the marker light to the surface.



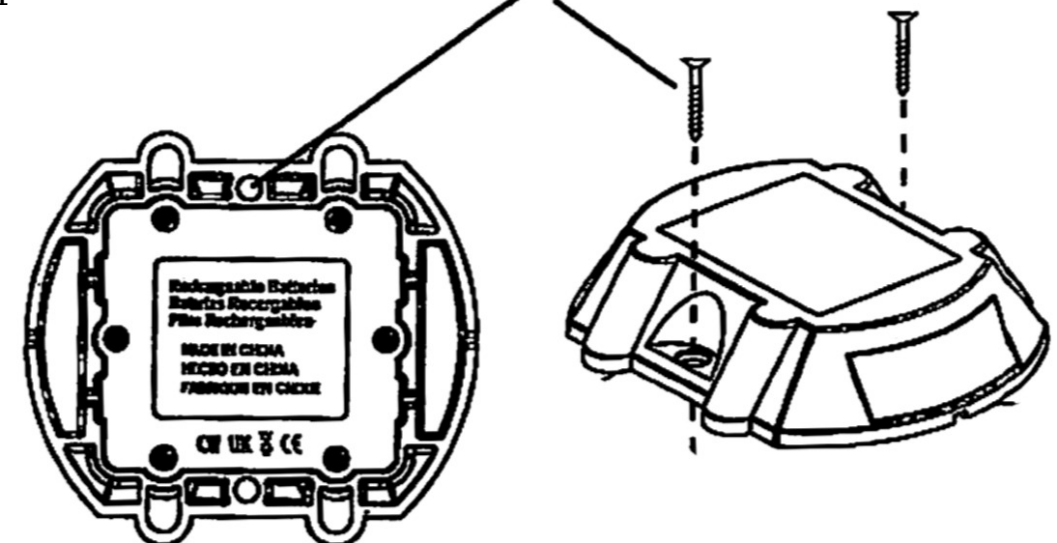
## Cautions:

Avoid installing the light in locations where water will pool during rain or other situations where the light could become submerged in water. The light is water resistant but not completely water proof.

Avoid installing the light in high traffic areas that could cause a trip hazard

Do not operate the light with the battery cover off or unsecured: water could infiltrate the battery compartment and damage the product.

## Trouble Shooting

**If the light does not turn on at night after 8 hours of charging:**

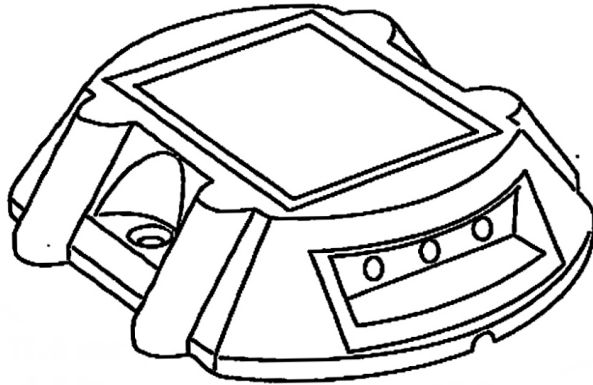
Ensure that the solar light is in a bright sunny location and not in a shady area during the day.

Make sure the light's photocell is not affected by other light sources at night.

Verify that the battery is making contact with the terminals and that the positive and negative poles are correct.
